SUGGESTED ROUTES (researched by Alan Holmes)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 21.0 miles (1,200' ascent) Bamburgh Castle, Fowberry, North Sunderland, Seahouses (PH), Annstead Links, Beadnell (PH), Tughall Mill Links, Newton Links, Low Newton (PH), Newton Pool, The Skaith, Dunstanburgh Castle, Craster (PH), Sugar Sands, Boulmer (PH), Foxton Hall to Alnmouth. 17.5 miles (1,050') Seahouses (PH), Annstead Links – then as walk 1. 15.0 miles (900') Beadnell (PH), Tughall Mill Links – then as walk 1. 12.5 miles (800') Newton Barns, High Newton (PH), Low Newton (PH), then as walk 1. 11.0 miles (700') Embleton (PH), The Skaith – then as walk 1. 9.5 miles (675') Stamford, Dunstan (PH), Craster (PH) – then as walk 1. 7.0 miles (425) Howick Corner, Cushat Wood, Sugar Sands, Boulmer (PH) – then as walk 1 to Alnmouth. 		
NOTES	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The coach will travel via the A1 and B1342 and, after Bamburgh, will travel south on the B1340 & B1339 roads. Should you wish to undertake a walk not represented here, the coach will drop off at any safe and convenient point, en-route between the A1 and Alnmouth. The walking routes follow the Northumberland Coastal Way / St Oswald's Way. There are three hostelrys in Alnmouth's main street (Northumberland Street), the Red Lion, the Sun Inn and the Hope and Anchor. All are worth a visit. The coach will park to the north-east of Alnmouth, by the golf course, and will pick-up in Northumberland Street, promptly at 6.30 pm.
