SUGGESTED ROUTES (researched by Alan Holmes)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 16.0 miles (1,860' ascent) Westgate, Bridge End, Carr Brow Pastures, Race Head, Sedling Fell, Bulman's Bridge, Allenheads (PH), Dirt Pot (Outdoor Centre), Peasmeadows, Knock Shield, Pry Hill, Park, Wooley Park, Allendale. 11.0 miles (1,150') Killhope Wheel, Allendale Common, Peasmeadows, then as walk 1. 11.0 miles (750') Killhope Cross, Coalcleugh, Carrshield Moor, Knock Shield, then as walk 1. (Note: this walk follows the course of Isaac's Tea Trail) 9.0 miles (620') Allenheads (PH), Dirt Pot (Outdoor Centre), then as walk 1 to Allendale. 7.5 miles (575') Dirt Pot Outdoor Centre, then as walk 1 to Allendale. 		
NOTES	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bear in mind that it gets dark early and there could be snow on the ground. Dress appropriately & carry spare clothing, a head torch, extra food & drink - plus gloves and an ice axe if necessary. Of course this is our Xmas walk! Whilst there are several pubs in Allendale to choose from, the two main ones being the Kings Head & the Golden Lion (both serving a good range of real ales), we will major on the Kings Head because they serve food throughout the day, are aware that we are coming and will set an area aside for us to run a quiz. (Kings Head: 01434 683681) Our coach will park close by the pub and will depart promptly at 6.30 pm.
