SUGGESTED ROUTES (researched by Alan Holmes)	<ol> <li>17.5 miles (2,400' ascent), Helmsley (PH), Cleveland Way to Cold Kirby, Dialstone Farm, Boltby Scar, C Way to Steeple Cross, Black Hambleton &amp; Square Corner, then descend via Oak Dale, Middlestye Bank to Osmotherley.</li> <li>17.5 miles (3,150'), Helmsley (PH), Cleveland Way to Ryedale Bridge, then Rievaulx, Ryedale, Hawnby (PH), Mount Pleasant, Thorodale, Cleveland Way, Black Hambleton &amp; Square Corner, continue as walk 1 to Osmotherley.</li> <li>14.5 miles (2,700'), Path from B1257 road down to Rievaulx, then as walk 2.</li> <li>12.0 miles (2,250'), Laskill House (B1257), Timber Holme, Easterside Farm, Hawnby (PH), then continue as walk 2.</li> <li>11.5 miles (1,350'), Sutton Bank, Cleveland Way to Whitestone Cliff, Boltby Scar, then continue as walk 1 to Osmotherley.</li> <li>10.5 miles (1,350'), Chop Gate (PH), Cock Howe, Green Howe, Pin Howe (Whorlton Moor), Miley Pike, Square Corner, then as walk 1 to Osmotherley.</li> </ol>
NOTES	<ol> <li>The coaches will travel out via Stokesley, Chop Gate and the B1257 to Helmsley; returning via the A170 to Sutton Bank &amp; the A19 to Osmotherley where they will park. Should you wish to undertake a different walk from those suggested above, the coaches will set you down at any safe &amp; convenient point along this route.</li> <li>End of walk hostelry: there are two good pubs in Osmotherley, the Golden Lion and the Queen Catherine Hotel. Both serve real ales and pub grub.</li> <li>The coaches will park close-by and will depart for home promptly at 6.30 pm.</li> </ol>
