<b>SUGGESTED ROUTES</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>16.0 miles</b> (2,800' ascent) Hutton-le-Hole to Fadell Rigg Farm, Bransdale Road, Ousegill Bridge, Shaw Ridge, Ouse Gill Head, West Gill Head, West Gill, Low Mill, Farndale riverside to Church Houses, Long Lane &amp; North Gill to Blakey Ridge, old railway line to Lion Inn.</li> <li>2. <b>13.0 miles</b> (2,400') Lion Inn to old railway line, north to Rosedale Head, Nab Scar, Low Baring &amp; cross Rosedale to Thorsgill, Stone Hags, Low Mill, then as walk 1 to Lion Inn</li> <li>3. <b>10.0 miles</b> (2,200') Hutton-le-Hole to Gillamoor Side, Lowna, Dale End Bridge, Rawson Syke, Low Mill, then as walk 1 to Lion Inn.</li> <li>4. <b>9.0 miles</b> (1,550') Lion Inn to old railway line, south to Stone Hags, descend to Low Mill, then as walk 1 to Lion Inn.</li> <li>5. <b>8.0 miles</b> (1,600') Saddle Stone, Blakey Ridge to the Dale End Road, bypass Hagg End Farm and descend into Farndale, Rawson Syke, Low Mill, then as walk 1 to Lion Inn.</li> </ol>
