SUGGESTED ROUTES	<div>1. 22.0 miles (5,100' ascent) Skelton, Saltburn, then via Cleveland Way to Skinningrove, Boulby, Staithes, Port Mulgrave, Runswick Bay, Kettleness, Sandsend, West Cliff to Whitby.</div> <div>2. 19.0 miles (4,300') From Brotton to Skinningrove, then as walk 1.</div> <div>3. 15.5 miles (3,300') From Easington to Boulby, then as walk 1.</div> <div>4. 13.5 miles (2,920') From Boulby Bank via Cleveland Way to Whitby.</div> <div>5. 11.5 miles (2,750') From Staithes via Cleveland Way to Whitby.</div> <div>6. 9.00 miles (1,730') From Runswick Bay via Cleveland Way to Whitby.</div>

NOTES	<div>1. Should you wish to undertake a walk not represented here, the coach will set down at any safe and convenient point en-route along the A174.</div> <div>2. Always walk with others and remember that dusk will be around 5.20 pm at this time of year! Please, plan your walk accordingly!</div> <div>3. 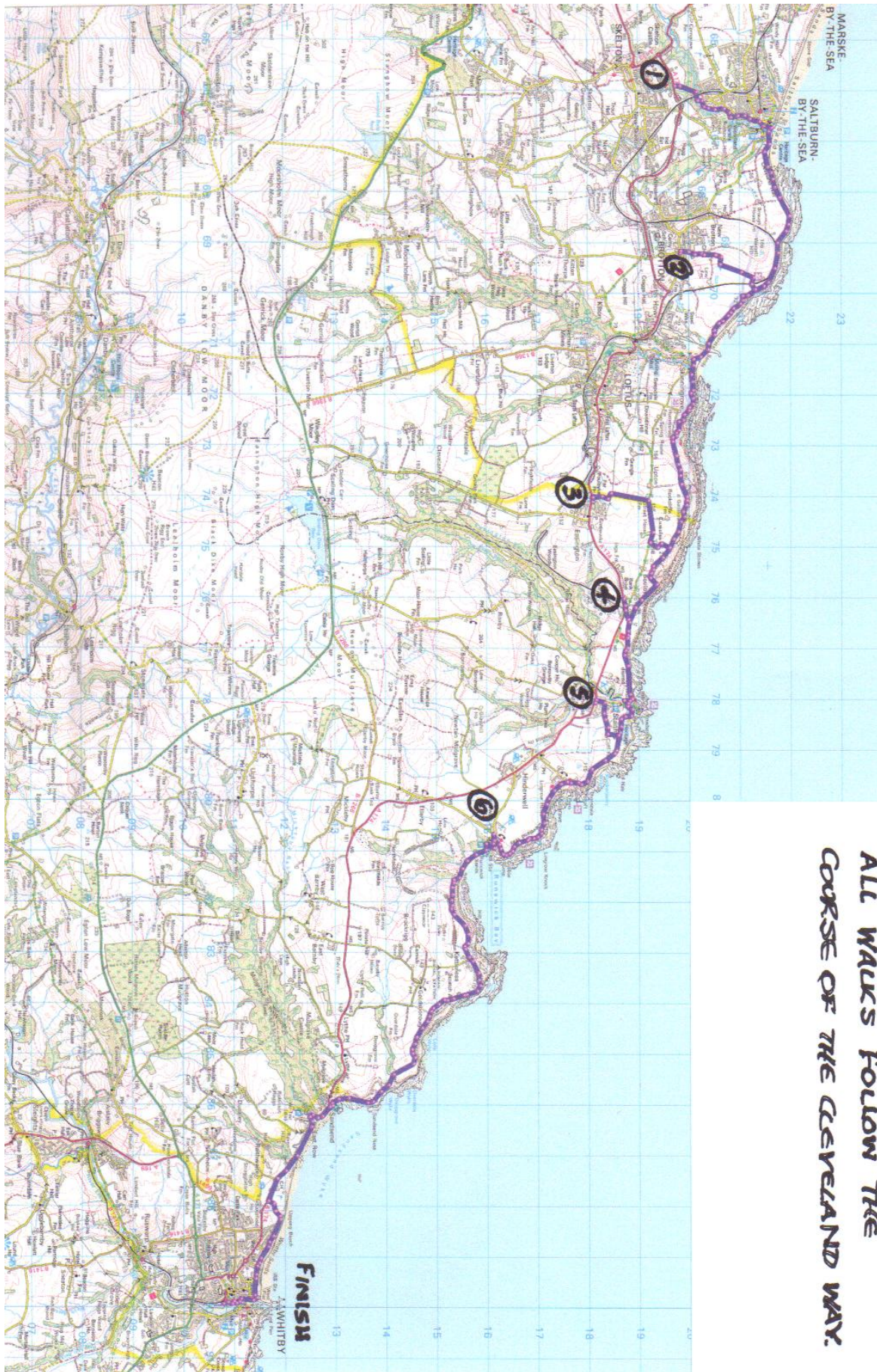
