SUGGESTED ROUTES	 15.0 miles (4,400' ascent) Seatoller, Honister Pass, Dale Head, Hindscarth, Littledale Edge, Robinson, High Snab Bank, Low House Farm, Little Town, Cat Bells, Swinside (PH), Newlands Beck side, Portinscale to Keswick. 11.0 miles (3,400') Seatoller, Honister Pass, Dale Head, High Spy, Maiden Moor, Cat Bells, Fawe Park, Portinscale to Keswick. 9.0 miles (2,600') Seatoller, High Scawdel, High Spy, then as walk 2. Note: Walks 2, 3 & 6 can be increased by 1.5 miles, by visiting the pub at Swinside - and then following route 1. 9.0 miles (1,200' Low Level) Seatoller, joining the Dales Way through the jaws of Borrowdale, Grange, Derwent Water side, Hawes End, Fawe Park, Portinscale to Keswick. 9.0 miles (2,100') Rosthwaite, Grange Fells, Watendlath, Caffell Side, Hogs Earth, Ashness Bridge, Walla Crag, Rakefoot to Keswick. 6.5 miles (1,600') High Lodore, Cat Bells, Fawe Park, Portinscale to Keswick

NOTES	 Darlington passengers please note change of pickup point. Should you wish to undertake a walk not represented here, the coach will set down at any safe and convenient point en-route along the B5289 road. Remember that it's always cooler at altitude. Dress warmly and take spare food plus a torch. Never walk on the hills alone; seek the company of others! There are a variety of pubs in Keswick for post-walk refreshments; the Pack Horse Inn (up in town) is one of the better ones, whilst the Bank Tavern is closest to the coach park.
