SUGGESTED ROUTES	 17.0 miles (6,000' ascent) Rosthwaite, Stonethwaite, Greenup Edge, High Raise, Langdale Pikes, Angle Tarn, Esk Hause, Great End, Scafell Pike, Sty Head, Stockley Bridge, Seathwaite, Rosthwaite. 2a. 14.0 miles (4,500') Rosthwaite, Thornythwaite Fell, Glaramara, Allen Crags, Esk Hause, Great End, Scafell Pike then as walk 1. 2b. 13.5 miles The reverse of walk 2a – but starting Seatoller, finishing Rosthwaite. 3a. 11.5 miles (2,700') Seatoller, Longthwaite, Stonethwaite, Greenup Gill, Greenup Edge, Ullscarf, Long Moss, Watendlath, Hazel Bank, Rosthwaite. 3b. 10.0 miles The reverse of walk 3a – but starting & finishing at Rosthwaite. 7.5 miles (1,700') Seatoller, Rosthwaite, Watendlath, Dock Tarn, Stonethwaite, Rosthwaite. 6.0 miles (1,600') As walk 4 but starting from Rosthwaite. 3.0 miles (300') Seatoller, Longthwaite, Stonethwaite, Rosthwaite.

NOTES	 Should you wish to undertake a different walk from those above, the coach will drop off at any safe point along the Borrowdale road. Due to parking restrictions in Rosthwaite, the coach will remain at Seatoller until close to departure time. On finishing the walk it is suggested that those wishing to enjoy the usual libations via the local hostelries should head directly there, rather than using the coach to change (thus saving a further mile walk). Local hostelries: two bars in Rosthwaite at the Scafell Hotel & Royal Oak Hotel. There's also a cosy pub at Stonethwaite, but you'll be faced with a mile long walk to get to the coach in Rosthwaite afterwards! (Allow at least 30 minutes!) The coach will park at Seatoller until close to departure time. At 6.15pm it will move to the Scafell Hotel, ready for departure at 6.30pm
