SUGGESTED ROUTES	<p>1. <b>20.0 miles</b> (1,600' ascent) Bingley Loop heading east alongside railway line, thence via Bingley, Stockbridge, Silsden, Kildwick, Bradley, Thorlby to the Anchor Inn, West Gargrave.</p> <p>2. <b>18.5 miles</b> (1,450') Starting from Bingley.</p> <p>3. <b>15.0 miles</b> (1,100') Starting from Stockbridge via Bar Lane.</p> <p>4. <b>12.0 miles</b> (850') Starting from Silsden via Silsden Bridge.</p> <p>5. <b>10.0 miles</b> (550') Starting from Kildwick via Kirkgate.</p> <p>6. <b>8.5 miles</b> (430') Starting from Bradley via Ings Lane.</p> <p>7. <b>3.5 miles</b> (160') Starting from Thorlby Lane End.</p> <p><u>Note:</u> All walks finish at the Anchor Inn, ½ mile west of Gargrave centre.</p>		
WALK CHAMPION	Suggested routes were proposed by: <b>Alan Holmes</b>		
NOTES	<p>1. The coach will travel via the A1 to J47, A59, A658, A657 to Shipley thence via A650, A629 &amp; A65 to Gargrave. Should you wish to undertake a different walk from those above, the coach will drop off at any safe point enroute.</p> <p>2. The following hostelries are on or nearby the canal: the Marquis of Granby, Riddlesden; Stockbridge Arms, Stockbridge; Bridge inn, Silsden; Bay Horse, Snaygill; the Narrow Boat, Skipton; the Anchor Inn, West of Gargrave.. (Don't consume too much alcohol; we don't want anyone falling into the canal!) There are two pubs in Gargrave itself: the Old Swan Inn &amp; the Mason's Arms.</p> <p>3. <b>The Masons Arms is recommended and will serve food for our party.</b></p> <p>4. The coach will park near the Anchor Inn ½ mile west of Gargrave. At 6.30 pm it will depart and collect walkers from outside the Mason's Arms before commencing the homeward journey (via A59 &amp; A61 to Ripon &amp; the A1) There'll be a comfort stop at Ripley during the return journey.</p>
