SUGGESTED ROUTES	<p>HADRIAN'S WALL ROUTES:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 17.5 miles (1,500' ascent) Linstock r/about, Linstock, Low Crosby (PH), Blea Tarn, Newtown, Walton (PH), Banks, Wall Bowers, Birdoswald to Gilsland. 15.0 miles (1,420') Low Crosby (PH), then as walk 1 to Gilsland 12.0 miles (1,300') Irthington (PH), Newtown, then as walk 1 to Gilsland 10.0 miles (1,170') Cam Beck, Walton (PH), then as walk 1 to Gilsland 9.0 miles (1,000') Brampton (PH's), Sawmill Lane, Boothby (PH), Lanercost, Banks, then as walk 1 to Gilsland 6.0 miles (730') Low Row (PH), Wall Bowers, then as walk 1 to Gilsland <p>HAYDON BRIDGE ROUTE:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 11.0 miles (2,000') Haydon Bridge, Lees Farm, Allen Banks, Staward Gorge, Staward Peel, Harsondale, West Deanraw, Langley Castle, Haydon Bridge.

NOTES	<p>Unusually, there'll be two independent & entirely separate walks on offer on this outing! The coach will travel out via A1M, A69 & A689 - setting down in Haydon Bridge before proceeding to the start of walk 1 at Linstock.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Gilsland: 2 pubs - Samson Inn and the Station Hotel. Haydon Bridge: 3 pubs – General Havelock, Railway Hotel & Anchor Hotel. The coaches will park near the Station Hotel, Gilsland & depart at 6.30 pm. They will then pickup en-route at Haydon Bridge central bus stop at 6.50 pm. Walkers at Haydon Bridge should be ready, awaiting collection by 6.45 pm. There'll be a comfort stop on the return journey, if necessary.

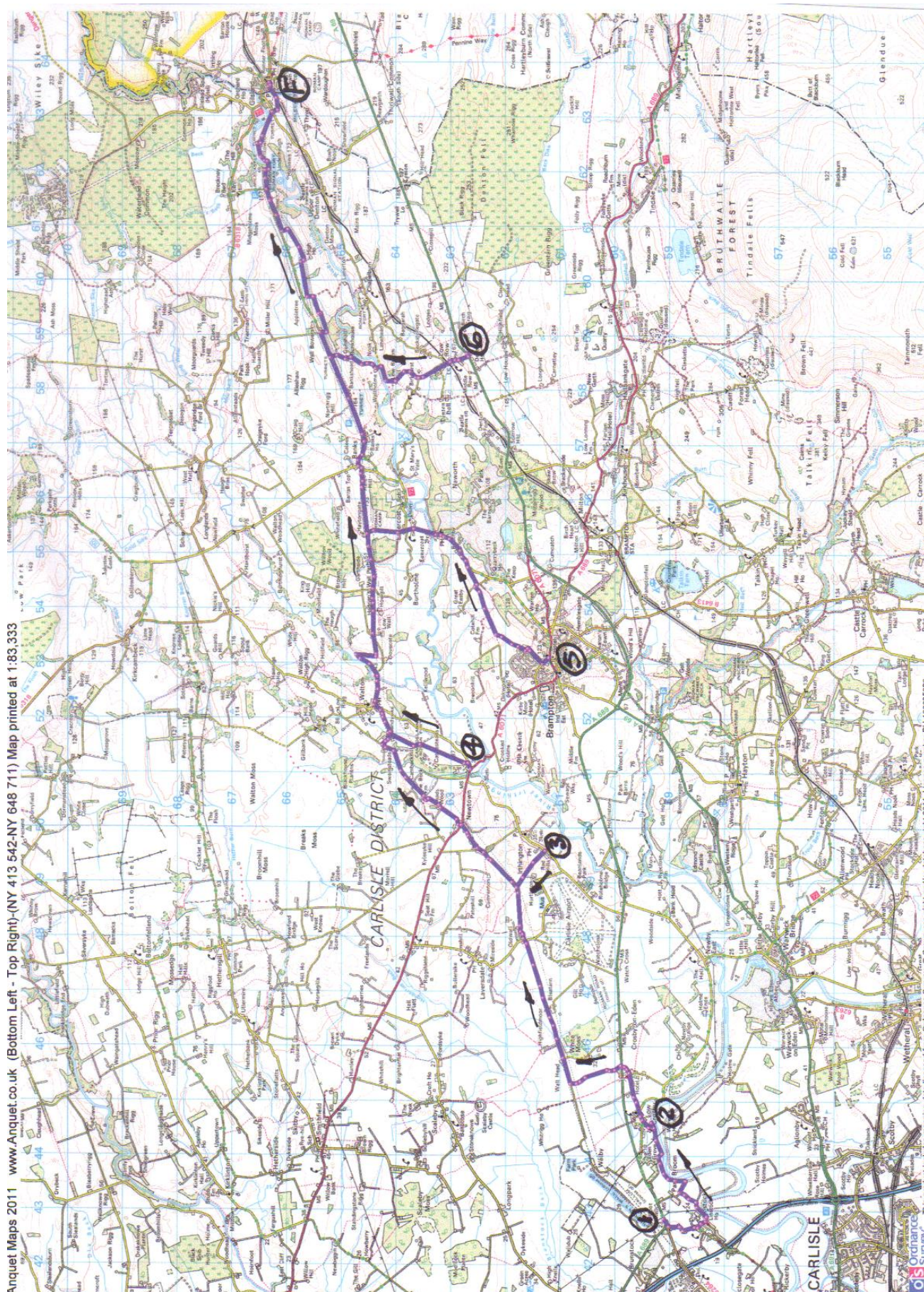
