SUGGESTED ROUTES	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 18.0 miles (2,000' ascent) Scaling Dam, Lealholm Moor, Lealholm (PH), Glaisdale, East Arncliffe Wood, Egton Bridge (PH), Grosmont Farm, Newbiggin Hall, Woodlands, Sleights (PH), Ruswarp to Whitby West Cliffe. 13.5 miles (1,600') Side Farm, Church Dale Farm, East Arncliffe Wood, then as walk 1 to Whitby. 12.5 miles (1,020') Scaling Dam, Lealholm Moor, Low Whinns Farm, Ughthorpe (PH), Mulgrave Woods, East Row (PH), Coastal Path to Whitby. 9.5 miles (1,150') Egton (PH), Grosmont Farm, then as walk 1 to Whitby. 8.5 miles (1,100') Grosmont, Grosmont Farm, then as walk 1 to Whitby. 8.0 miles (600') Ughthorpe Lane End, Ughthorpe (PH) then as walk 3 to Whitby <p>APOLOGIES BUT DUE TO MY HARD DRIVE FAILURE THERE ISN'T A MAP (I'm hoping to address this problem for the January walk.)</p>

Should you wish to undertake a walk not represented here, the coach will set down at any safe and convenient point en-route.
