<b>SUGGESTED ROUTES</b>  (researched by Alan Holmes)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>16.0 miles</b> (1,830') Fox &amp; Rabbit Inn, Farwath, Levisham (PH), Dundale Rigg, Levisham Moor, Gallows Dike, Old Wife's Way, Blakey Topping, Newgate Brow, Bridestones, Stain Dale, Thornton Dale, Ellerburn, Thornton Le Dale.</li> <li><b>11.0 miles</b> (1,050') Saltergate, Levisham Moor, Dundale Rigg, Levisham (PH), Farwath, Fox &amp; Rabbit Inn, Thornton Dale – then as walk 1.</li> <li><b>10.0 miles</b> (850') Saltergate, Old Wife's Way - then as walk 1.</li> <li><b>10.0 miles</b> (1,200') Saltergate, Low Horcum, Horcum Slack, Levisham Beck, Lockton, x Lockton Lane, Staindale Lodge, Thornton Dale – then as walk 1.</li> <li><b>6.0 miles</b> (500') Lockton road end, Staindale Lodge, Thornton Dale then as 1.</li> <li><b>5.0 miles</b> (400') Fox &amp; Rabbit Inn, Thornton Dale, Ellerburn – then as walk 1 to Thornton Le Dale.</li> </ol>		
NOTES	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bear in mind that this is a winter walk. It gets dark early and there could be snow on the ground. Dress appropriately &amp; carry spare clothing, head torch, extra food &amp; drink - plus gloves and an ice axe if necessary.</li> <li>Should you wish to undertake a walk not represented here, the coach will set down at any safe and convenient point en-route.</li> <li>The coach will park in a large coach park on the south-east side of the village of Thornton Le Dale, accessed via a footbridge across the stream in the centre.</li> <li>There are two key pubs in Thornton Le Dale, both serve food and are just a short distance from the coach park: The New Inn (01751 474226) and the Buck Inn (01751 474212)</li> <li>The coach(es) will depart for home at 6.30 pm prompt.</li> </ol>
