SUGGESTED ROUTES

(researched by Alan Holmes)

1. **12.5 miles** (3,250' ascent) Crag Houses, Buttermere, High Snockrigg, Robinson, Hindscarth, High Craggs, Scope End, Low Snab, Little Town, Skelgill, Stair, Newlands Beck, Little Braithwaite, Hodgson How, Portinscale, to Keswick.
2. **11.0 miles** (2,700') Crag Houses, Buttermere, High Snockrigg, Robinson, High Snab Bank, Chapel Bridge, Little Town, then as walk 1 to Keswick.
3. **9.5 miles** (2,000') Crag Houses, Buttermere, Newlands Hause, Knot Rigg, Ard Craggs, Rigg Beck, Rowling End Farm, Stair, then as walk 1 to Keswick.
4. **9.0 miles** (1,500', lower level) Crag Houses, above Mill Beck, below Whiteless Breast, Bleak Rigg, x Addacombe Beck, Rigg Beck, Rowling End Farm, Stair, then as walk 1 to Keswick.

NOTES

1. Should you wish to undertake a different walk from those above, the coach will drop off at any safe point along the road between Keswick & Crag Houses. Note that the small car park at Crag Houses is where the coach(es) will turn, to return along Lorton Vale on their way back over Whinlatter Pass to Keswick.
2. The coach will park at the usual place in Keswick, i.e. Booths Supermarket coach park. It will leave for home promptly at 6.30 pm.
3. There are a number of suitable real ale hostleries in Keswick, the best is arguably the Packhorse (up into the town and left through an arch off the main street); the Bank Tavern is most convenient, being nearest the coach park.
