<b>SUGGESTED ROUTES</b>  (researched by Alan Holmes)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>15.5 miles</b> (3,100' ascent) Troutbeck (Town Head), High Street (Roman Road), Thornthwaite Crag, Rampsgill Head, High Raise, Wether Hill, Loadpot Hill, Barton Fell, Roehead to Pooley Bridge.</li> <li><b>13.0 miles</b> (2,850') Patterdale, Rooking, Boredale Hause, Angletarn Pikes, Rampsgill Head, High Raise - then as walk 1 to Pooley Bridge.</li> <li><b>10.0 miles</b> (2,300') Patterdale, Rooking, Boredale Hause, Place Fell, Sandwich, Howtown (PH), Sharrow Bay, Waterside House to Pooley Bridge.</li> <li><b>9.5 miles</b> (1,250') Patterdale, Silver Point, Sandwich, Howtown (PH), - then as walk 3 to Pooley Bridge.</li> <li><b>6.0 miles</b> (950') As walk 4 as far as Howtown – then board the ferry and complete your outing with a sail on Ullswater to Pooley Bridge.</li> <li><b>4.0 miles</b> (300') Start with a boat ride from Glenridding to Howtown, then walk to Pooley Bridge via Sharrow Bay &amp; Waterside House.</li> </ol>		
NOTES	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The coach will travel out via Tebay and Kendal to Troutbeck, returning along Patterdale to the A5091, thence via Dockray &amp; Troutbeck to the A66, before heading for Penrith, where it will return south along the B5320 to Pooley Bridge.</li> <li>Should you wish to undertake a walk not represented here, the coach will set down at any safe and convenient point along the above route.</li> <li>End of walk hostelry. There are several pubs in Pooley Bridge to choose from.</li> <li>The coach will park in the village as near as possible to the pubs. It will depart for home promptly at 6.30pm, travelling via the B5320 and the A66.</li> </ol>
