<b>SUGGESTED ROUTES</b>  (researched by Alan Holmes)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>14.0 miles</b> (3,100' ascent), Kirkstone Pass (PH), Stony Cove Pike, Thornthwaite Beacon, Froswick, Ill Bell, Yoke, Buck Crag, Garburn Nook, Sour Howes, Hugill Fells, Reston Scar to Staveley.</li> <li><b>10.5 miles</b> (1,700'), Troutbeck (PH), Church Bridge, The Howe, Garburn Road (track), Garburn Nook, Sour Howes, Hugill Fells, Reston Scar to Staveley.</li> <li><b>10.0 miles</b> (1,450'), Troutbeck (PH), Church Bridge, The Howe, Longmire Road (track), Far Orrest, Near Orrest, Orrest Head, x A591 road (be careful!), Heathwaite, Pinethwaite, then via the Dales Way to Hag End, Crag House, New hall and Staveley.</li> <li><b>8.0 miles</b> (1,200'), Moorhowe Road, Far Orrest, Near Orrest, Orrest Head, x A591 road (be careful!), Heathwaite, Pinethwaite, then via the Dales Way to Hag End, Crag House, New hall and Staveley.</li> </ol>		
<b>NOTES</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The coach will travel out via the M6, Kendal by-pass, A591 &amp; A592, returning the same way. Should you wish to undertake a different walk from those suggested above, the coach will set you down at any convenient point en-route.</li> <li>There are two pubs in Staveley, the Duke William and the Eagle &amp; Child. Both are worth a visit, but the Eagle &amp; Child, at GR SD 471 980, has a wider range of real ales and will accommodate us with food.</li> <li>The coach will park near the village centre &amp; it will depart promptly at 6.30 pm.</li> </ol>
