SUGGESTED ROUTES (researched by Alan Holmes)	<div>1. Original Route from 40 years ago! 19.5 miles (4,800' ascent), Ribblesdale, Gunnerfleet Farm, Whernside, Chapel-Le-Dale (PH), Ingleborough, Sulber, Horton, Horton Scar, Pen-y-ghent, Brackenbottom, to Horton-in-Ribblesdale.</div> <div>2. 13.5 miles (3,150'), Chapel-Le-Dale (PH), Ingleborough, then as walk 1.</div> <div>3. 8.0 miles (2,000'), Ingleton, Ingleborough, Dales High Way to Sulber, then descending past Beecroft Hall to finish at Horton-in-Ribblesdale.</div> <div>4. 19.5 miles (4,700'), Ingleton, Ingleborough, Trow Gill, Thwaite, Austwick (PH), Feizor, Helwith Bridge (PH), Churn Milk Hole, Pen-y-ghent, Horton Scar to Horton-in-Ribblesdale.</div> <div>5. 13.0 miles (2,600'), Clapham (PH), Austwick (PH), then as walk 4 to Horton.</div> <div>6. 7.0 miles (650'), Rawlinshaw, Feizor, Helwith Bridge (PH), then alongside the River Ribble in Ribblesdale to Horton-in-Ribblesdale.</div>			
NOTES	<div>1. The coaches will travel out via Hawes and the B6255 to Ribblesdale & Ingleton, thence via A65 to Settle, continuing via B6479 to Horton. Should you wish to undertake a different walk from those suggested above, your coach driver will set you down at any safe and convenient point along this route.</div> <div>2. There are two pubs in Horton; The Crown to the north and the Golden Lion to the south. The Golden Lion serves food all day – tel: 01729 860206 but The Crown (no meals until 6 pm) is much nearer to where our coaches will park!</div> <div>3. As usual, the coaches will depart for home promptly at 6.30 pm.</div>
