NOTES	 To facilitate the longer walks from Langdon Beck area it is necessary for passengers to transfer between coaches during the outward journey - at Staindrop. Those doing walks 1 & 2 must transfer to the smaller coach whilst those doing walks 3,4 & 5 must transfer to the larger coach. End of walk hostelry: There are several pubs in the Market Square across the bridge in Appleby. There's the Crown & Cushion, the Hare & Hounds is opposite & probably the best, the Golden Ball, down a side street beside the Post Office. There's also the Midland Hotel bar, right next to the train station! The coaches will park at the train station (NY 686207) until 6.15pm. They will then move into town & pick up in The Sands, opposite the bridge, at 6.30pm. Please be ready waiting! Whilst on the coach please refrain from using the onboard toilet facility. There'll be a comfort stop during the return journey, at Barnard Castle.
