SUGGESTED WALK ROUTES	<ol> <li>Tursdale Junction 08.20 these pickup details will be subject to change!</li> <li>23.0 miles (1,320' ascent) Warkworth (PH), Alnmouth (PH), Boulmer (PH), Howick, Craster (PH), Dunstanburgh Castle, The Skaith, Low Newton-by-the-Sea (PH), Beadnell (PH), Seahouses (PH).</li> <li>18.5 miles (1,000') Alnmouth (PH), Boulmer (PH), then as walk 1.</li> <li>14.0 miles (560') Longhouton (PH), Low Stead, Howick, then as walk 1.</li> <li>12.0 miles (420') Stamford, Dunstan (PH), Craster (PH), then as walk 1.</li> <li>8.5 miles (330') Embleton (PH), The Skaith, then as walk 1.</li> </ol>
